Pro Tools® software version 2022.12 provides the following new features and enhancements:

- Public Beta for running natively on Apple M1 and M2 Silicon processors
- Support for macOS 13.0.1 (“Ventura”)

Control+N	Hold down the Control key and press the N key

Right-click	Click with the right mouse button

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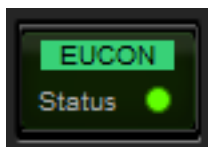

EUCON Status Control

Pro Tools provides EUCON Status Control that can be shown (or hidden) in the Edit Window toolbar.

To show (or hide) the EUCON Status Control in the Edit Window toolbar:

- In the Edit Window Toolbar menu, enable (or disable) EUCON.



EUCON Status Control

EUCON Toggle

The EUCON button lets you toggle EUCON control on and off for Pro Tools.

To enable (or disable) EUCON control:

- Click EUCON so that it is lit (or click EUCON so that it is unlit).

EUCON Status Indicator

Status indicator

Status	Indicator Color	Description
Disabled	Greyed Out	EUCON disabled
Enabled	Light Green	EUCON enabled but not connected to EuControl/WSControl
Connected	Green	EUCON enabled and connected to EuControl/WSControl and surface
Warning or a minor error	Orange (click to clear)	Warning or a minor error that does not stop the connection
Serious error	Flashing Red (click to stop flashing)	Serious error (Network packets dropped) Disable and re-enable EUCON to clear the error

Improved Support for Markers in Sessions Exported from Media Composer

Media Composer 2022.12 can export Pro Tools session files with markers that work with all versions of Pro Tools. When opening sessions exported from Media Composer 2022.12:

- Pro Tools 2022.12 places the Media Composer comment field text into the Pro Tools memory location name field. The memory location comments also contain the Media Composer track name and marker color. This results in the same behavior as for markers imported from a Media Composer generated AAF.
- Versions prior to Pro Tools 2022.12 show the Media Composer marker name in the Pro Tools memory location name field—this is a one-to-one mapping of name field, and the Media Composer marker name typically contains the Media Composer username.

Public Beta of Native Apple Silicon Support

Pro Tools 2022.12 can run natively on Apple M1 and M2 Silicon processors as a public beta. Running natively on Silicon provides significant performance improvements over running on Rosetta. For more information, visit: [Pro Tools Apple Silicon public beta](#) online.

Pro Tools launches in the qualified “Rosetta” mode by default, so you will need to do the following to run Pro Tools natively in “Silicon” mode.

To set Pro Tools to run natively on Apple Silicon:

- 1 Locate the Pro Tools application icon, right-click on the icon and choose Get Info.
- 2 Deselect the Open Using Rosetta option.
- 3 Launch Pro Tools.

On launch, Pro Tools presents a warning that this is a public beta.

Support for macOS Ventura

Pro Tools 2022.12 now supports macOS 13.0.1 (“Ventura”).



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
