## Security Guidelines Update

Currently, CrowdStrike is only supported up to v7.0.3 (macOS and Windows). Do not install v7.0.4 or later at this time.

## Fixed in Media Composer v2022.12.6

The following have been fixed:

- **Bug Number:** MCCET-4179. Match Frame did not work properly after applying a dissolve between two clips and a Motion Effect or “Fit to Fill” was used.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-4835. Depending on source media, Gang button was unexpectedly enabled when using Match Frame in MultiCamera mode.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5135. MultiCamera edits containing a muted group clip with a Temporal (motion) Adapter created a blank clip after selecting “Commit Multicam Edits”.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-4692. Modifying values in a bin’s Auxiliary TC1 column caused an “Assertion failed: FALSE File” error if the clips were at non-standard frame rates, such as 15 fps.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5214. Audio was out of phase when using “Proxy Preferred” instead of “High-Resolution Only” playback.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-4639. Muting clips with an alpha layer on the timeline produced an “Assertion failed: parent File” or “Exception: FATAL\_ERROR” error.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-4209. Media Composer crashed when using Segment Mode to drag nested clips between tracks in a Matte Key.

- **Bug Number:** MCCET-3491. Using Waveform Analysis or Source Timecode to create an autosynced subclip did not work properly, resulting in clips that would not sync or were out of sync by a frame or more.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5219. Using ScriptSync with Modern Standard Arabic (MSA) resulted in an “Error syncing... The file could not be opened” message. The corresponding AvidLanguagePacks installer was “Arabic (Modern Standard)”.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5308. (Windows) “Multi-Input mode” text was scaled incorrectly in the Audio Suite Effect Dialog user interface.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5318. Using Lift or Extract with Digital Audio Scrub enabled caused Media Composer to crash.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5292. AMA Mapping error occurred if essence data was unavailable for some tracks.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5066. Source Browser did not consistently ingest media from P2 cards.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5061. Audio waveforms would not redraw properly if both “Show Marked Waveforms” and “Show Marker Regions” were enabled in the Timeline settings.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5333. (MediaCentral | Production Management) Matte Keys with a duration longer than two minutes would not appear as rendered.
- **Bug Number:** MCDEV-17422. Connecting to iNews using the NRCS tool triggered an installation of Avid Media Composer.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5339. Enabling the Play Length Toggle caused Media Composer to crash in v2022.12.5 only.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-3909. Media Composer appeared to hang on launch when using a checked-out license with no VPN connection to the license server.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5356. Performing Send to Playback with the “Transcode before sending to playback” option enabled in the Transfer Settings window could result in a message that media was offline. After clicking OK to acknowledge the message, media became online.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5358. In some instances, XDCAM media became offline when using Dynamic Relink in v2022.12.5 only.
