ReadMe for Media Composer<sup>®</sup> v2023.12.2

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## Fixed in Media Composer v2023.12.2

The following have been fixed for all applicable models of Media Composer in this update (First, Standard, Ultimate, and Enterprise):



*Bug fixes will only apply to those features available for a particular model.*

- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5481. Selecting the “Choose for me” option in the New Project Settings window and clicking “Create” caused an “Incorrect value for width and height” error, even though raster dimensions are determined at a later stage.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5130. In some instances, after opening a project stored on a NEXIS workspace, the Project and Bin Container Sidebars were blank, and did not display any bins or folders.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5520. ALE files containing a column name with more than 32 characters produced an error message and would not import.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5337. In some instances, Media Composer would not remain activated after relaunch when using a floating license, requiring users to check the “Use License server” box again after restarting.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5518. Using Edit mode in the NRCS Tool to save edits containing MOS objects (for example, those created by VizRT Mosart) could cause an assertion error.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5131. MOV files that contained audio and video of different lengths could go offline after enabling Dynamic Relink.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5447. Text in the Media Composer Classic layout was not readable if the User Interface Settings for “Interface brightness” were set to the brightest or second brightness UI colors (two rightmost options).

- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5453. When editing a group clip, the video and audio sometimes became offset for group clips created by consolidating a sequence that only used the video (no audio) track of a group clip.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5538. Custom columns did not appear after importing an ALE file with the “Merge events with known master clips” option enabled in User Settings.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5539. In some instances, importing an ALE file containing a mismatch between duration values caused an “Exception: BIN\_IMPORT\_NO\_MATCH” error.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5557. Audio in the original masterclip could relink to consolidated media after clips were consolidated with Dynamic Relink enabled.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5548. Video in a 50p project became out of sync with audio after a few minutes or more of playback on an external monitor using a DNxIQ or DNxIQ interface.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5536 and MCCET-5496. (MediaCentral | Production Management) In some instances, opening a sequence with Dynamic Relink enabled caused Media Composer to become unresponsive.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5521. Audio playback was garbled after using digital audio scrub and playing back media using a VM.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-4836. In some instances, audio pops occurred while editing remotely with Media Composer using Teradici on a system with NDI and SRT plug-ins installed.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5325. Results for the Find Script command included large portions of a clip that spanned multiple script marks.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-5565. Using Digital Audio Scrub on a remote workstation or VM with HP Anyware (Teradici) caused audio to distort.

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
