Installation Note

On a Windows® system, if you have already installed a patch on your system, you must first uninstall the previous patch before installing a new patch.

On a Macintosh system, there is a full installer, not just a patch. You must completely uninstall the previous Macintosh version.

Fixed in v6.5.5 and v10.5.5

The following have been fixed:

- **Bug Number:** MCCET-664. In some instances, when the Audio Punch In was tool open and you played back a sequence containing audio with pre-roll, the audio waveform was not displayed.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-702. Performing an audio punch in with “remove extra filler after punch-in” enabled and pre/post handles enabled resulted in a lost dissolve or crash.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-900. In some instances, performing a Send to Playback resulted in video and audio being out of sync.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-1134. Subcap global properties were not applied after restarting Media Composer.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-1042. You might have received a “Cannot open bin” error when trying to open a bin greater than 2GB.

- **Bug Number:** MCCET-863. (News option) The welcome message from iNews when displayed in the NRCS Tool did not show Croatian specific characters.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-574. When you performed an AMA File export, the file might not have been placed in the path location that was selected.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-168. After transcoding Canon media, the video column did not update to display the transcoded media.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-61. Portions of the Timeline would disappear when using ScriptSync on a Mac system. You would have to refresh the Timeline for the portions to appear again.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-835. The left side justification of text in a Subcap effect might not have been aligned properly.
- **Bug Number:** MCCET-1193. (Interplay environment) You might have received a “Could not find INT_EFF_SPATIAL ADAPTER” error trying to check in a sequence from NewsCutter v10.5.4.6 that had previously been rendered and checked in from a NewsCutter v11.0.5 editing application.
